



Order under Section 78(6) Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Centurion Property Associates Inc. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Chris Huth and Sherwin Huth (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on November 7, 2025, with respect to application LTB-L-049030-25.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenants to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenants if the Tenants do not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenants have not met the following condition(s) specified in the order:
 - a) **On December 12th, the Landlord's pest control contractor discovered the Tenants had failed to prepare the rental unit for treatment, thereby preventing the treatment.**

It is ordered that:

1. Order LTB-L-049030-25 is cancelled.
2. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated. The Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before January 17, 2026.
3. If the unit is not vacated on or before January 17, 2026, then starting January 18, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.

4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after January 18, 2026.
