



**Order under Section 78(6)
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

In the matter of: 311, 330 GERRARD ST E

Between: Toronto Seniors Housing Corporation Landlord

And

Nhac Duong Tenant

Toronto Seniors Housing Corporation (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Nhac Duong (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on November 17, 2025 with respect to application LTB-L-076711-25-SA.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenant if the Tenant does not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following conditions specified in the order:

The Tenant failed to permit the Landlord to perform their monthly inspections of the rental unit.

The Tenant also denied the Landlord access to the rental unit.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before January 18, 2026.
2. If the unit is not vacated on or before January 18, 2026, then starting January 19, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
3. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after January 19, 2026.
