



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

In the matter of: 707, 273 PHARMACY AVE.
SCARBOROUGH ON M1L3E9

Between: Homestead Land Holdings Limited Landlord

And

Beraki Habte Mhretab Tenant

Homestead Land Holdings Limited (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Beraki Habte Mhretab (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

A hearing was held by videoconference on December 16, 2025.

Only the Landlord's representative, Ashleigh Searles, attended the hearing.

As of 1:50 p.m., the Tenant was not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. As a result, the hearing proceeded with only the Landlord's evidence.

Determinations:

1. The Tenant paid the Landlord all the rent that was in arrears up to December 31, 2025.
2. The only amount owing is the Landlord's cost of filing the application. As a result, the order will be limited to costs only.
3. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), and find that it would not be unfair to grant relief from eviction pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Act.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$186.00, for the cost of filing the application.

2. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before January 16, 2026, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from January 17, 2026, at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
