



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

In the matter of: 15, 812 BROADVIEW AVE

Between: Neighbours Community Homes Landlord

And

Trevor Telfer Tenant

Neighbours Community Homes (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Trevor Telfer (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was mediated by videoconference on December 15, 2025.

The Landlord agent Luba Lmarkoukis, the Tenant Trevor Telfer and the Tenant's Housing Support worker Ka Ki Yuen attended the hearing.

The parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters at issue in the application and requested an order on consent and I am satisfied that the parties understand the consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

1. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
2. The lawful rent is \$582.00. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
3. The rent arrears owing to December 31, 2025 are \$3,488.52.
4. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
5. Accordingly, the total amount owing for the arrears is \$3,674.52.
6. The Tenant shall pay \$2,074.52 towards the arrears and the remaining balance of \$1,600.00 will be paid by the Ontario Disability Support Program.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$2,074.52 towards the arrears of rent for the period ending on December 31, 2025, and costs.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:
 - a) **\$150.00** on or before the **1st day** of each month starting **February 1, 2026**, through to and including **February 1, 2027**, and;
 - b) A final payment of **\$124.52** on or before **March 1, 2027**.
3. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord new rent on time and in full as it comes due and owing for the period **January 1, 2026** to **March 1, 2027**, or until the arrears are paid in full, whichever date is earliest.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after **December 31, 2025**.
