Liliana Lopez Escobar (the 'Tenant') applied for an order determining that JDM Apartments Inc. and Stephen Smith (the 'Landlords') :

- substantially interfered with the reasonable enjoyment of the rental unit or residential complex by the Tenant or by a member of their household.
- harassed, obstructed, coerced, threatened or interfered with the Tenant.

An Adjudicative Case Conference (ACC) was held by videoconference on January 7, 2026.

Only the Landlord's legal representative, Sabrina Marchionne, attended the ACC.

As of 9:53 AM, the Tenant was not present or represented at the ACC although properly served with notice of this ACC by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the ACC.

Determinations:

1. Since the Tenant did not attend the ACC to support their application, I find that this application has been abandoned.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenant's application is dismissed.
