



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Capreit Limited Partnership (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Lisa John (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

The application was scheduled to be heard by video conference on January 13, 2026, at which time the parties elected to participate in Board facilitated mediation with the assistance of Dispute Resolution Officer Monique Browne

The Landlord's Representative Jason Paine, the Tenant Lisa John were present. The Tenant didn't speak with Tenant Duty Counsel.

As a result of the mediation, the parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters raised in the application and requested an order on consent, and I am satisfied that the parties understand the consequences of their consent.

It is ordered on Consent that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$15,573.58 which represents the arrears of rent and cost of the application fee outstanding for the period ending January 31, 2026.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:
 - a) \$2700.00 on or before January 20, 2026; and
 - b) \$1200.00 on or before the 20th day of each month starting February 20, 2026, through to and including November 20th, 2026; and
 - c) a final payment of \$873.58 on or before December 20, 2026.

3. The Tenant shall also pay the Landlord the lawful rent in full and on time, on or before the first day of each corresponding month for the months of February 2026 to December 2026, or until there are no arrears owing, whichever comes first.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after January 31, 2026.
