Vishnu Reghunathan, Dinesh Selvamani, Kerisan Subramanian and Muni Lokesh Sannadi (the 'Tenants') applied for an order determining that Shine Leelabai (the 'Landlord') collected or retained money illegally.

The Tenants applied for an order determining that the Landlord: entered the rental unit illegally; altered the locking system on a door giving entry to the rental unit or residential complex without giving the Tenants replacement keys; substantially interfered with the reasonable enjoyment of the rental unit or residential complex by the Tenants or by a member of their household; harassed, obstructed, coerced, threatened or interfered with the Tenants; and withheld or interfered with their vital services or care services and meals in a care home.

The Tenants also applied for an order determining that the Landlord failed to meet the Landlord's maintenance obligations under the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') or failed to comply with health, safety, housing or maintenance standards.

This application was heard by videoconference on January 14, 2026.

Only the Landlord and the Landlord's representative Fiona Tobin attended the hearing.

As of 9:31 a.m., the Tenants were not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing.

Determinations:

1. Since the Tenants did not attend the hearing to support their application, I find that this application has been abandoned.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenants' application is dismissed.
