



Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

In the matter of: 1218, 5000 JANE ST

Between: N.H.D. Developments Limited Landlord

And

Patrick Boateng Tenant

N.H.D. Developments Limited (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Patrick Boateng (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was mediated by videoconference on January 19, 2026.

The Landlord Representative Nicole Ruby and the Tenant Patrick Boateng attended the hearing.

The parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters at issue in the application and requested an order on consent and I am satisfied that the parties understand the consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

1. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
2. The lawful rent is \$1,718.00. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
3. The rent arrears owing to January 31, 2026 are \$3,165.00.
4. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
5. Accordingly, the total amount the Tenant owes the Landlord is \$3,351.00
6. For one time only the lawful monthly rent for **February 2026** will be due on **February 5, 2026** instead of **February 1, 2026**. Thereafter, the lawful monthly rent will be due on the 1st day of each month.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$3,351.00 for arrears of rent up to January 31, 2026 and costs.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 on or before **February 13, 2026**.
3. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord new rent on time and in full as it comes due and owing on **February 5, 2026** or until the arrears are paid in full, whichever date is earliest.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after **January 31, 2026**.
