



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Greenwin Corp (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Shirley Williams (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

The application was scheduled to be heard on January 22, 2026, by video conference, at which the parties decided to participate in Board facilitated mediation with the assistance of Dispute Resolution Officer/Hearings Officer, Kevin Kordahi.

The Landlord's Representative, Matt Anderson, the Tenant's Support, Tiffany Stewart, and the Tenant, Shirley Williams were present.

As a result of the mediation the parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters at issue in the application and requested an order on consent and I am satisfied that the parties understand the consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

1. The parties agree to amend the application to remove Alka Grover as a tenant.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$2,320.00. This amount represents \$2,134.00 for arrears of rent up to January 31, 2026, and \$186.00 for the application filing fee.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:
 - \$1,500.00 on or before January 22, 2026.
 - \$137.00 on or before the 1st day of each month, beginning February 1, 2026, up to and including June 1, 2026.
 - \$135.00 on or before July 1, 2026.

3. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord new rent on time and in full as it comes due and owing for the period February 1, 2026, to July 1, 2026, or until the arrears are paid in full, whichever date is earliest.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after January 31, 2026.
