



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

In the matter of: 501, 25 BRIDESBURG DR
ETOBICOKE ON M9R2K6

Between: CAPREIT LIMITED PARTNERSHIP Landlord

And

ELIZABETH YANET PINO OSORIO Tenant

CAPREIT LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict ELIZABETH YANET PINO OSORIO (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

The Landlord also claimed compensation for each day the Tenant remained in the unit after the termination date.

The application was heard by videoconference on January 27, 2026. The Landlord's legal representative Jason Paine and the Tenant attended the hearing.

At the hearing, the parties engaged in mediation. As a result of the resolution discussion, the parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters at issue in the application and requested an order on consent. I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent, and specifically that the tenancy would terminate.

Agreed Facts:

1. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
2. The lawful rent is \$2,440.06. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
3. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$80.22. This amount is calculated as follows: \$2,440.06 x 12, divided by 365 days.
4. The Tenant has not made any payments since the application was filed.
5. The rent arrears owing to January 31, 2026 are \$9,609.70.
6. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

7. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$2,440.06 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord.
8. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$3.79 is owing to the Tenant for the period from January 1, 2026 to January 27, 2026.

On consent of the parties, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before February 16, 2026.
2. The Tenant shall pay the Landlord any rent arrears owing up to the date of the hearing and the cost of filing the application. The amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenant.
3. As of the date of the hearing, the Tenant owes the Landlord \$7,077.73. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
4. The Tenant shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$80.22 per day for the use of the unit starting January 28, 2026 to the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
5. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before February 16, 2026, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from February 17, 2026 at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
6. If the unit is not vacated on or before February 16, 2026, then starting February 17, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
7. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after February 17, 2026.
