Greenwin Corp (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict CLAUDE WALTER (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

The Landlord's legal representative, Matt Anderson, and the Tenant attended the hearing.

Determinations:

1. At the hearing, the parties agreed to adjourn this matter so the Landlord could confirm whether the Tenant had made recent payments to the Landlord. The parties' request to adjourn was granted.
2. On January 29, 2026, the Landlord submitted a written request to withdraw this application. The Landlord's application is therefore dismissed as withdrawn.

1. The Landlord's application is dismissed as withdrawn.
