



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

GREENBOARD HOLDINGS LTD (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict PATRICK WINSTON DAWKINS and ATHENA MOGENT (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on January 29, 2026.

Before the start of the hearing the Landlord's Legal Representative, Geoff Paine, and the Tenant engaged in private settlement discussions and advised that the parties had reached an agreement.

The parties requested that Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Michelle Forrester provide assistance in finalizing the terms and issue an order on consent to resolve all matters raised in the application.

Upon reviewing the terms of the consent with the parties, I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

Agreed facts:

1. The Landlord served the Tenant with a Notice to End Tenancy Early for Non-payment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenant did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$1,392.34. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$45.78. This amount is calculated as follows: $\$1,392.34 \times 12$, divided by 365 days.

5. The Tenant has paid \$3,500.00 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to January 31, 2026, are \$(89.56).
7. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
8. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,392.34 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$2.32 is owing to the Tenant for the period from January 1, 2026, to January 29, 2026.

On consent of the parties, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated unless the Tenant voids this order.
2. **The Tenant may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$1,488.78 if the payment is made on or before February 16, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenant may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenant has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after February 16, 2026, but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
4. **If the Tenant does not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before February 16, 2026.**
5. As of the date of the hearing, the amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit exceeds the arrears of rent, compensation and the cost of filing the application the Landlord is entitled to by \$1,362.94. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing. However, the Landlord is authorized to deduct from the amount owing to the Tenant \$45.78 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting January 30, 2026, until the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
6. The Landlord or the Tenant shall pay to the other any sum of money that is owed as a result of this order.
7. If the unit is not vacated on or before February 16, 2026, then starting February 17, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
8. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after February 17, 2026.

Plus daily compensation owing for each day of occupation starting January 30, 2026	\$45.78 (per day)
