Nethanjali Nedra Wijesekera and Nyomi Saleka Khan (the 'Tenants') filed a motion to set aside order LTB-L-067943-25 because, before the eviction order was enforced, the Tenants paid the amount required under subsection 74(11) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') to void the order.

This motion was heard by videoconference on February 5, 2026. The Landlord's representative Anome Mehrabian, and the Tenants, attended the hearing.

The Landlord agrees the Tenants paid the amount required to void the order as well as the cost the Landlord paid to the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) for the purpose of enforcing the eviction.

It is ordered that:

1. Order LTB-L-067943-25 is void and cannot be enforced by the Landlord.
