



Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

In the matter of: 202, 1617 VICTORIA PARK AVE

Between: Parkwoods Management Inc. Landlord

And

Simone Reid Tenant

Parkwoods Management Inc. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Simone Reid (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on February 5, 2026.

Richard Hissey appeared as the Landlord's legal representative. The Tenant attended the hearing and was self-represented.

Through mediation, the parties agreed to the following order on consent. I was satisfied that the parties understood and agreed to the terms below.

On consent of the parties, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated unless the Tenant voids this order.
2. **The Tenant may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$2,181.57 if the payment is made on or before February 24, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenant may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenant has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after February 24, 2026 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
4. **If the Tenant does not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before February 24, 2026.**

5. As of the date of the hearing, the amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit exceeds the arrears of rent, compensation and the cost of filing the application the Landlord is entitled to by \$1,456.66. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing. However, the Landlord is authorized to deduct from the amount owing to the Tenant \$64.28 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting February 6, 2026 until the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
6. The Landlord or the Tenant shall pay to the other any sum of money that is owed as a result of this order.
7. If the unit is not vacated on or before February 24, 2026, then starting February 25, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
8. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after February 25, 2026.
