



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Akelius Canada Ltd (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Amadeus Wheesk and Alexandra Caron-Martin (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

The application was scheduled to be heard by video conference on February 10, 2026. Before the start of the hearing, the Landlord's Representative, Emily Barbati and the Tenant, Amadeus Wheesk, on behalf of the Tenants, advised that the parties had reached an agreement.

The parties requested that Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Sarah Visnovec issue an order on consent to resolve all matters raised in the application.

Upon reviewing the terms of the consent with the parties, I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

Agreed facts:

- a) The lawful rent is \$1,033.75. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
- b) Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$33.99. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,033.75 x 12, divided by 365 days.
- c) The Tenants have paid \$4,257.22 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
- d) The rent arrears owing to February 28, 2026 are \$847.75.
- e) The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

- f) The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$934.58 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
- g) Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$92.33 is owing to the Tenants for the period from July 21, 2020 to February 10, 2026.

On consent, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated unless the Tenants void this order.
2. **The Tenants may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$1,033.75 if the payment is made on or before February 28, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenants may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenants have paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after February 28, 2026 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
4. **If the Tenants do not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before February 28, 2026.**
5. As of the date of the hearing, the amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit exceeds the arrears of rent, compensation and the cost of filing the application the Landlord is entitled to by \$687.01. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing. However, the Landlord is authorized to deduct from the amount owing to the Tenants \$33.99 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting February 11, 2026 until the date the Tenants move out of the unit.
6. The Landlord or the Tenants shall pay to the other any sum of money that is owed as a result of this order.
7. If the unit is not vacated on or before February 28, 2026, then starting March 1, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
8. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after March 1, 2026.
