**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

SKPM Rents 3 (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict DELLANA HICKSON and NOEL WRIGHT (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on February 5, 2026.

The Landlords Legal Representative Sharon Harris and the Tenant Noel Wright attended on behalf of both tenants.

The parties requested that Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Jennifer Buckminster provide assistance in finalizing the terms and issue an order on consent to resolve all matters raised in the application.

Upon reviewing the terms of the consent with the parties, I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

The Tenants have made a payment of \$300.00 on January 29th, 2026. This payment is not reflected on the Landlords portal because it takes 5-7 business days to clear. Once the payment has cleared this amount will be deducted from the total amount the Tenant is identified as owing below.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The lawful rent is \$1,741.04. It is due on the first day of each month.
2. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$57.24. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,741.04 x 12, divided by 365 days.

3. The Tenants have paid \$5,224.08 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
4. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
5. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,707.47 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
6. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated unless the Tenants void this order.
7. **The Tenants may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - a. \$2,041.04 if the payment is made on or before February 28, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
8. The Tenants may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenant has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after February 28, 2026, but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
9. **If the Tenant does not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before February 28, 2026.**
10. As of the date of the hearing, the amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit exceeds the arrears of rent, compensation and the cost of filing the application the Landlord is entitled to by \$892.31. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing. However, the Landlord is authorized to deduct from the amount owing to the Tenants \$57.24 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting February 10, 2026, until the date the Tenants move out of the unit.
11. If the unit is not vacated on or before February 28, 2026, then starting March 1, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
12. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after March 1, 2026.
