



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

O'Shanter Development Company Ltd. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Akinbolu Elemide and Ambrose Kibuuka-Wassaaka (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

The application was scheduled to be heard by video conference on February 19, 2026.

Before the start of the hearing the Landlord's legal representative Lindsay Goldberg, the Landlord's agent Madhuri Malhotra and the Tenants Akinbolu Elemide and Ambrose Kibuuka-Wassaaka, engaged in private settlement discussions and advised that the parties had reached an agreement.

The parties requested that Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Diego Fernandez-Stoll provide assistance in finalizing the terms and issue an order on consent to resolve all matters raised in the application.

Upon reviewing the terms of the consent with the parties, I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

The parties agreed that:

1. The lawful rent is \$3,151.87. It is due on the 1st day of month.
2. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$103.62. This amount is calculated as follows: \$3,151.87 x 12, divided by 365 days.
3. The Tenants have paid \$5,223.36 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
4. The rent arrears owing to February 28, 2026 are \$5,383.33.
5. The Tenants shall pay the Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application.

6. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$3,000.00 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit shall be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy.
7. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$8.63 is owing to the Tenants for the period from January 1, 2026 to February 19, 2026.

On consent of the parties, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated unless the Tenants void this order.
2. **The Tenants may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$5,569.33 if the payment is made on or before February 28, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.

OR

- \$8,721.20 if the payment is made on or before March 31, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenants may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenants have paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after March 31, 2026 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenants may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
 4. **If the Tenants do not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before March 31, 2026**
 5. If the Tenants do not void the order, the Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$1,377.61. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to the date of the agreement and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenants. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
 6. The Tenants shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$103.62 per day for the use of the unit starting February 20, 2026 until the date the Tenants move out of the unit.
 7. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before March 31, 2026, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from April 1, 2026 at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
 8. If the unit is not vacated on or before March 31, 2026, then starting April 1, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.

9. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after April 1, 2026.
