



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Ranee Management (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Jamie Belfield (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent owed.

This application was heard by videoconference on February 23, 2026.

Only the Landlord's Representative, Heather Butt, attended the hearing.

As of 9:54 a.m., the Tenant was not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. As a result, the hearing proceeded with only the Landlord's evidence.

Determinations:

1. The Landlord served the Tenant with a valid Notice to End Tenancy Early for Non-payment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenant did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$1,700.26. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$55.90. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,700.26 x 12, divided by 365 days.
5. The Tenant has paid \$3,700.00 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to February 28, 2026, are \$6,501.58.

7. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
8. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,700.26 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$23.28 is owing to the Tenant for the period from July 1, 2025, to February 23, 2026.
10. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), including the Payment Agreement agreed to by parties on February 19, 2026, and uploaded to the portal on February 20, 2026, and find that it would not be unfair to grant relief from eviction subject to the conditions set out in this order pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) and 204(1) of the Act.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$6,687.58 for arrears of rent up to February 28, 2026, and costs.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:

3. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord new rent on time and in full as it comes due and owing for the period from March 1, 2026, to December 1, 2026, or until the arrears are paid in full, whichever date is earliest.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of

the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after February 28, 2026.
