Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Kim Mckenzie (the 'Tenant') filed a motion to set aside order LTB-L-072254-25 because, before the eviction order was enforced, the Tenant paid the amount required under subsection 74(11) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') to void the order.

This motion was heard by videoconference on March 2, 2026.

The Landlord's Legal Representative, Eric Steiman, and the Tenant attended the hearing.

Determinations:

1. The Tenant has not previously made a motion under subsection 74(11) of the Act to set aside an eviction order during this tenancy.
2. The Tenant has paid to the Landlord the amount required under subsection 74(11) of the Act to void the eviction order.
3. The Landlord has paid the Sheriff's costs under the *Administration of Justice Act* for the purpose of enforcing the Landlord's eviction order and this amount is non-refundable. The Tenant has already paid the Landlord this amount.

It is ordered that:

1. Order LTB-L-072254-25 is void and cannot be enforced by the Landlord.
