



Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Hersz Properties Limited (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Jan Fekech and Jatagandzidu Froso (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

This application was heard by videoconference on March 2, 2026.

The Landlord's Representative, Sean Beard, and the Tenant, Jan Fekech, attended the hearing.

Determinations:

1. The Landlord served the Tenants with a valid Notice to End Tenancy Early for Non-payment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenants did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenants were still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$1,257.27. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$41.33. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,257.27 x 12, divided by 365 days.
5. The Tenants have paid \$2,540.00 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to March 31, 2026, is \$2,975.65.
7. The Tenants believes they owe the Landlord any arrears. The Tenant, Jan Fekech, testified that he spoke to the Landlord's staff, and they asked him to get a bank letter which

the bank denied. The Tenants were given an opportunity to send their bank records for payments made, as post-hearing submissions which they failed to do. The Landlord submitted a ledger, and I have no reason to find that the ledger is inaccurate. Therefore, I am granting the amounts claimed by the Landlord.

8. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
9. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,098.29 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
10. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$31.31 is owing to the Tenants for the period from January 1, 2025, to March 2, 2026.
11. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), including whether the Landlord attempted to negotiate a repayment agreement with the Tenants, and find that it would not be unfair to postpone the eviction until April 30, 2026 pursuant to subsection 83(1)(b) of the Act.
12. The Tenants have lived at the rental unit for decades and I am willing to grant the Tenants some time to pay off the balance and preserve their tenancy.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated unless the Tenants void this order.
2. **The Tenants may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$3,161.65 if the payment is made on or before March 31, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
- OR**
- \$4,418.92 if the payment is made on or before April 30, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenants may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenants have paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after April 30, 2026, but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenants may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
4. **If the Tenants do not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before April 30, 2026.**
5. If the Tenants do not void the order, the Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$857.44. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to the date of the hearing and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are

deducted from the amount owing by the Tenants. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.

6. The Tenants shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$41.33 per day for the use of the unit starting March 3, 2026, until the date the Tenants move out of the unit.
7. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before April 30, 2026, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from May 1, 2026, at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
8. If the unit is not vacated on or before April 30, 2026, then starting May 1, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
9. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after May 1, 2026.
