



**Order under Section 78(6)
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

And

DANIEL SARPONG Tenant

GREENBOARD HOLDINGS LTD (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict DANIEL SARPONG (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on January 8, 2026, with respect to application LTB-L-041978-25.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenant if the Tenant does not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following condition specified in the order:

The Tenant failed to remove any excessive clutter from the rental unit that would interfere with the Landlord's reasonable pest control efforts.

On March 10, 2026, the Landlord conducted an inspection of the rental unit and observed excessive clutter throughout. The clutter extended from the entrance hallway into the living room, leaving a pathway of less than one metre. There were large storage barrels placed directly in front of the entrance walkway, and garbage bags and loose clothing piled throughout the hallway in living area, obstructing access within the rental unit.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before April 3, 2026.

2. If the unit is not vacated on or before April 3, 2026, then starting April 4, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
3. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after April 4, 2026.
