



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Pinedale Properties Ltd. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Agnidipa Bhattacharjee and Keshob Chakrabartty (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

The parties attended a hearing on March 16, 2026, by video conference, to which the parties elected to participate in Board facilitated mediation with the assistance of Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Roxanne Theriault.

The Landlord's Legal Representative, Jennifer Smith and the Tenants were present.

As a result of the resolution discussion, the parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters at issue in the application and requested an order on consent. I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

The parties agreed that:

1. The Landlord served the Tenants with a Notice to End Tenancy Early for Non-payment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenants did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenants were still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$2,132.76. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$70.12. This amount is calculated as follows: \$2,132.76 x 12, divided by 365 days.
5. The Tenants have not made any payments since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to March 31, 2026, are \$8,349.72.

7. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
8. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,949.52 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$11.89 is owing to the Tenants for the period from December 1, 2025, to March 16, 2026.
10. The parties agreed to a final, non-voidable termination of this tenancy as of March 31, 2026. As such, the Tenants do not have the option to void the eviction order by paying the outstanding rent arrears.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated. The Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before March 31, 2026.
2. The Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$5,563.47. This amount includes rent arrears owing to the date of the hearing and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenants. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenants shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$70.12 per day for the use of the unit starting March 17, 2026, until the date the Tenants moves out of the unit.
4. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before March 31, 2026, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from April 1, 2026 at 4.00% annually on the outstanding balance.
5. If the unit is not vacated on or before March 31, 2026, then starting April 1, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
6. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after April 1, 2026.
