



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Medallion Corporation (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Charles Darryl Garcia and Frances Mae Bautista Manet (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

A hearing was held by videoconference on March 18, 2026.

Only the Landlord's Representative, Samuel M Korman, attended the hearing.

As of 1:59 p.m., the Tenants were not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. As a result, the hearing proceeded with only the Landlord's evidence.

Determinations:

1. The Tenants paid the Landlord all the rent that was in arrears up to March 31, 2026.
2. The only amount owing is the Landlord's cost of filing the application. As a result, the order will be limited to costs only.
3. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), and find that it would not be unfair to grant relief from eviction pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the Act.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$186.68, for the total arrears and the cost of filing the application.

2. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before April 6, 2026, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from April 7, 2026, at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
