



**Order under Section 78(6)
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

And

Sue Karansue Tenant

Toronto Community Housing Corporation (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Sue Karansue (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on September 5, 2025, with respect to application LTB-L-014899-23.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenant if the Tenant does not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following condition specified in the order:

On March 12, 2026, the Tenant approached the superintendent inquiring about pest control in the rental unit. The superintendent informed the Tenant that pest control treatment was cancelled as the Tenant advised they did not require it. The Tenant began to scream so to de-escalate the situation, the superintendent asked the Tenant to leave. The Tenant then kicked the superintendent's door and continued to scream in their face. The superintendent made a report to management and Special Constable Bhullar. This information is based on the declaration made by the Landlord in the L4 application.

It is ordered that:

1. Order LTB-L-014899-23 is cancelled.
2. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before April 10, 2026.

3. If the unit is not vacated on or before April 10, 2026, then starting April 11, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after April 11, 2026.
