



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

And

CARINE KEZA Tenant
JOSEPHA KAMBANDA

CAPREIT LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict CARINE KEZA and JOSEPHA KAMBANDA (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was scheduled to be heard by videoconference on March 23, 2026. The Landlord's legal representative, Reshma Nair, the Tenant, Josepha Kambanda and the Tenant's support, Marina DeOliveira attended the hearing. Josepha Kambanda had authorization to consent on behalf of all parties.

Before the start of the hearing, the parties advised that they had reached an agreement. As a result of the resolution discussion, the parties mutually agreed to resolve all matters at issue in the application and requested an order on consent.

I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

1. The lawful monthly rent is \$2,250.45. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
2. The arrears of rent owing to March 31, 2026, inclusive of the application filing fee of \$186.00 are \$2,667.29.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$2,667.29, which represents the arrears of rent owing to March 31, 2026 and the application filing fee of \$186.00.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:

- a. A payment of \$67.29 on or before April 1, 2026; and
 - b. A payment of \$2,600.00 on or before April 15, 2026.
3. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord new rent on time and in full as it comes due and owing on April 1, 2026 or until the arrears are paid in full, whichever date is earliest.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance owed to the Landlord by the Tenant shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after March 31, 2026.
