



Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Between: FALCO PROPERTIES Landlord

And

HASSAN ADAM Tenant

FALCO PROPERTIES (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict HASSAN ADAM (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was scheduled to be heard by videoconference on March 10, 2026. Instead, the Landlord's Agent, Nancy Gallucci, and the Tenant participated in a mediation session. The parties reached an agreement and requested an order on consent to resolve the application.

The Tenant spoke with Tenant Duty Counsel prior to the mediation.

I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

1. The lawful rent is \$1,439.80. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
2. The rent arrears owing to February 28, 2026 are \$4,807.25.
3. The Landlord incurred costs of \$201.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

It is ordered on consent of the parties that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$5,008.25 for arrears of rent up to March 31, 2026 and the cost of filing the application.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:
 - Monthly payments of \$1,000.00 by the last day of each month, starting March 31, 2026, and continuing until June 30, 2026; and
 - A final payment of \$1,008.25 on or before July 31, 2026.

3. The Tenant shall also pay to the Landlord new rent on time and in full as it comes due and owing for the period between April 1, 2026 to July 1, 2026, or until the arrears are paid in full, whichever date is earliest.
4. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after March 31, 2026.
5. This order on consent is in full and final settlement of this application.
