



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

GABRIEL ALLISTAIR LASHLEY Tenant

2-12 KINGSTON RESIDENCES CORP. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict GABRIEL ALLISTAIR LASHLEY (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was scheduled to be heard by videoconference on April 7, 2026.

The Landlord, represented by Lily McMillan and the Tenant engaged in mediation with Dispute Resolution Officer, Cheryl Lavoie. As a result of the resolution discussion, the parties reached a settlement of all issues arising from the Application up to the date of the hearing.

The parties before the LTB consented to the following order:

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$2,100.00 for arrears of rent up to April 30, 2026, plus \$186.00 for the application filing fee. The total amount the Tenant shall pay to the Landlord is \$2,286.00.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord the amount set out in paragraph 1 in accordance with the following schedule:
 - a) \$2,286.00 on or before April 23, 2026.
3. If the Tenant fails to make any one of the payments in accordance with this order, the outstanding balance of any arrears of rent and costs to be paid by the Tenant to the Landlord pursuant to paragraph 1 of this order shall become immediately due and owing and the Landlord may, without notice to the Tenant, apply to the LTB within 30 days of the Tenant's breach pursuant to section 78 of the Act for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenant and requiring that the Tenant pay any new arrears, NSF fees and related charges that became owing after April 30, 2026.
