



Order under Section 78(6) Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

And

Lorraine Palmer Tenant

Toronto Seniors Housing Corporation (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Lorraine Palmer (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not meet a condition specified in the order issued by the LTB on December 10, 2025 and April 1, 2026, with respect to applications LTB-L-079636-25 and LTB-L-010225-26-SA.

This application was decided without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. The order provides that the Landlord can apply to the LTB under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') without notice to the Tenant to terminate the tenancy and evict the Tenant if the Tenant does not meet certain condition(s) in the order. This application was filed within 30 days of the breach.
2. I find that the Tenant has not met the following condition(s) specified in the order:
 - a) **On April 14, 2026, the Tenant refused entry to the rental unit for the Pest Control Technician to perform the treatment.**

It is ordered that:

1. Order LTB-L-079636-25 is cancelled.
2. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated. The Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before May 2, 2026.
3. If the unit is not vacated on or before May 2, 2026, then starting May 3, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
4. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after May 3, 2026.
