



Order under Section 69 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

2597775 ONTARIO INC (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict STEFAN AZIZ (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on February 25, 2026.

Only the Landlord's Legal Representative, Daniel Moak attended the hearing.

As of 9:51 a.m., the Tenant was not present or represented at the hearing although properly served with notice of this hearing by the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. As a result, the hearing proceeded with only the Landlord's evidence.

Determinations:

1. The Landlord served the Tenant with a valid Notice to End Tenancy Early for Non-payment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenant did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
3. The lawful rent is \$2,500.00. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
4. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$82.19. This amount is calculated as follows: \$2,500.00 x 12, divided by 365 days.
5. The Tenant has paid \$7,656.00 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to February 28, 2026 are \$2,154.00.
7. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

8. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$2,500.00 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$25.60 is owing to the Tenant for the period from September 1, 2025 to February 25, 2026.
10. I have considered all of the disclosed circumstances in accordance with subsection 83(2) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), including whether the Landlord attempted to negotiate a repayment agreement with the Tenant and find that it would be unfair to grant relief from eviction pursuant to subsection 83(1) of the Act.
11. At the hearing, the Landlord's Legal Representative sought a postponement of eviction to March 31, 2026 to allow the Tenant an opportunity to pay the rent outstanding in full as the Tenant had made significant attempts to pay down the arrears. At the hearing, I consented to the Landlord's uncontested request. However, due to Board error, this order was not issued and the requested termination date has now passed. I am not aware of any of the Tenant's circumstances that might give rise to a reason to delay or deny eviction. As a result, I find it would be unfairly prejudicial to the Landlord to postpone eviction any further.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated unless the Tenant voids this order.
2. **The Tenant may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$9,840.00 if the payment is made on or before May 15, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenant may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenant has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after May 15, 2026 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
4. **If the Tenant does not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before May 15, 2026.**
5. As of the date of the hearing, the amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit exceeds the arrears of rent, compensation and the cost of filing the application the Landlord is entitled to by \$630.85. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing. However, the Landlord is authorized to deduct from the amount owing to the Tenant \$82.19 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting February 26, 2026 until the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
6. The Landlord or the Tenant shall pay to the other any sum of money that is owed as a result of this order.

7. If the unit is not vacated on or before May 15, 2026, then starting May 16, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
8. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after May 16, 2026.
