



Order under Section 31 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Norma Parra (the 'Tenant') applied for an order determining that Akelius Canada Ltd (the 'Landlord') harassed, obstructed, coerced, threatened or interfered with the Tenant.

Determinations:

1. The Tenant filed this T2 application on March 31, 2026. The Board has not yet scheduled the matter for a hearing.
2. On May 7, 2026, the Tenant submitted a request to withdraw the application.
3. The Tenant's T2 application alleges the Landlord breached paragraph 4 of section 29(1) of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the Act) and as such, the Tenant requires the consent of the Board to withdraw their T2 application.
4. The reasons for the request to withdraw the application do not show or suggest the Tenant is under any undue influence in making the request. The Tenant explains the issues in the application have been resolved. Pursuant to section 200(3) of the Act, I consent to the Tenant's request to withdraw the application.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenant's application is withdrawn. The Board's file is closed.
