



Order under Section 31 Residential Tenancies Act, 2006

Sterling Karamar Property Management Landlord

Ashwini Ganesh Iyer (the 'Tenant') applied for an order determining that Sterling Karamar Property Management (the 'Landlord') substantially interfered with the reasonable enjoyment of the rental unit or residential complex by the Tenant or by a member of their household, harassed, obstructed, coerced, threatened or interfered with the Tenant and withheld or interfered with their vital services or care services and meals in a care home.

The Tenant also applied for an order determining that the Landlord failed to meet the Landlord's maintenance obligations under the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') or failed to comply with health, safety, housing or maintenance standards.

This order was issued without a hearing being held.

Determinations:

1. On May 9, 2026, the Tenant filed a request to withdraw the application. Pursuant to section 200 of *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act'), I consent to the Tenant's request to withdraw.

It is ordered that:

1. The Tenant's application is withdrawn.
