



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

File Number: LTB-L-015344-26

In the matter of: 302, 155 BALLIOL ST

Between: Amelin Property Management Landlord

And

Alma Bella F Sandejas Tenant

Amelin Property Management (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Alma Bella F Sandejas (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was heard by videoconference on April 29, 2026.

Only the Landlord's Agent, Michael Holzberg, attended the hearing.

As of 11:19 a.m., the Tenant's son, TJ Di Macali, attended the hearing but did not have authorization to represent the Tenant's interest at the LTB. There was no record of a request to adjourn the hearing. As a result, the hearing proceeded with only the Landlord's evidence.

Determinations:

1. The Landlord served the Tenant with a valid Notice to End Tenancy Early for Non-payment of Rent (N4 Notice). The Tenant did not void the notice by paying the amount of rent arrears owing by the termination date in the N4 Notice or before the date the application was filed.
2. The Tenant was in possession of the rental unit on the date the application was filed.
3. The Landlord discovered at the hearing, that the Tenant passed away on February 7, 2026. Per section 91 of the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006 (the 'Act'), the tenancy is deemed terminated 30 days after the death of the Tenant on March 9, 2026. Rent arrears are calculated up to the date the tenancy terminated.
4. The lawful rent is \$2,900.00. It was due on the 1st day of each month.
5. The Tenant has not made any payments since the application was filed.
6. The rent arrears owing to March 9, 2026, are \$3,685.56.

7. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
8. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$2,900.00 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit is applied to the arrears of rent because the tenancy terminated.
9. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$11.35 is owing to the Tenant for the period from January 1, 2026 to March 9, 2026.

It is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated as of March 9, 2026, the date the Tenant moved out of the rental unit.
2. The Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$960.21. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to the date the Tenant moved out of the rental unit and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit is deducted from the amount owing by the Tenant. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before May 31, 2026, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from June 1, 2026 at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
