



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

STEPHANIE WARNER Tenant

240 Markland Drive LP (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict STEPHANIE WARNER (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

This application was to be heard by videoconference on May 20, 2026. The Landlord's representative, Sylwia McArthur, and the Tenant, Stephanie Warner attended the hearing. The Tenant did not speak with Tenant Duty Counsel before the start of mediation.

The parties elected to participate in Board facilitated mediation with the assistance of Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) John Russett. The parties agreed to resolve the issues in the Landlord's application and requested the LTB to issue a Consent Order confirming their agreement.

I was satisfied that the parties understood the consequences of the Consent.

The parties agree that:

1. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
2. The lawful rent is \$2,461.79. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
3. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$80.94. This amount is calculated as follows: $\$2,461.79 \times 12$, divided by 365 days.
4. The Tenant has paid \$7,571.37 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
5. The rent arrears owing to May 31, 2026 are \$2,275.79.
6. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

7. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$2,411.57 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
8. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$19.42 is owing to the Tenant for the period from January 1, 2026 to May 20, 2026.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated unless the Tenant voids this order.
2. **The Tenant may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**
 - \$2,461.79 if the payment is made on or before May 31, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.

OR

- \$4,923.58 if the payment is made on or before June 15, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenant may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenant has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after June 15, 2026 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
 4. **If the Tenant does not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before June 15, 2026.**
 5. As of the date of the hearing, the amount of the rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit exceeds the arrears of rent, compensation and the cost of filing the application the Landlord is entitled to by \$812.19. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing. However, the Landlord is authorized to deduct from the amount owing to the Tenant \$80.94 per day for compensation for the use of the unit starting May 21, 2026 until the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
 6. The Landlord or the Tenant shall pay to the other any sum of money that is owed as a result of this order.
 7. If the unit is not vacated on or before June 15, 2026, then starting June 16, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
 8. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after June 16, 2026.
