



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

Between: METCAP LIVING MANAGEMENT INC Landlord

And

PAUL INCE Tenant
MARCIA INCE

METCAP LIVING MANAGEMENT INC (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict PAUL INCE and MARCIA INCE (the 'Tenant') because:

- the Tenant has been persistently late in paying the Tenant's rent.

The Landlord also claimed compensation for each day the Tenant remained in the unit after the termination date.

This application was scheduled to be heard by videoconference on May 14, 2026. The Landlord's legal representative, Stella Idahosa, the Tenants, the Tenants' daughter, Shamara Ince and the Tenant's support person, Melody Pomares were present.

The parties reached consent and requested an order on consent confirming their agreement. I was satisfied the parties understood the terms and consequence of this order.

It is agreed that:

The Tenants paid the application filing fee.

On consent of the parties, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants continues if the Tenants meet the conditions set out below.
2. The Tenants shall pay to the Landlord the lawful rent on time and in full for 12 months starting on June 1, 2026, to May 1, 2027.

3. If the Tenants fail to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph 2 of this order, the Landlord may apply under section 78 of the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006* (the 'Act') for an order terminating the tenancy and evicting the Tenants. The Landlord must make the application within 30 days of a breach of a condition. This application is made to the LTB without notice to the Tenants.
