



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

And

Shantell Watt Tenant

Signet Group Inc. (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict Shantell Watt (the 'Tenant') because the Tenant did not pay the rent that the Tenant owes.

The application was scheduled to be heard on May 20, 2026, by video conference. Before the start of the hearing, the parties engaged in private settlement discussions and advised that they had reached a settlement to resolve all matters at issue in the application. They requested an order on consent. The matter was referred to Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Nancy Fahlgren to assist in finalizing the terms and issue the requested order.

The Landlord's representative, Matt Anderson, and the Tenant were present. The Tenant met with Duty Counsel prior to the hearing.

Upon reviewing the terms of the consent with the parties, I was satisfied that the parties understood the terms and consequences of their consent.

Agreed Facts:

1. As of the hearing date, the Tenant was still in possession of the rental unit.
2. The lawful rent is \$1,873.74. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
3. Based on the monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$61.60. This amount is calculated as follows: \$1,873.74 x 12, divided by 365 days.
4. The Tenant has paid \$2,500.00 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
5. The rent arrears owing to May 31, 2026 are \$4,917.90.
6. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.
7. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$1,769.59 from the Tenant and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
8. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$14.25 is owing to the Tenant for the period from January 1, 2026 to May 20, 2026.
9. The Landlord and the Tenant further agreed to an order that permits the Tenant to preserve the tenancy and avoid eviction by paying the full amount owing as set out in this Order, including any additional rent that becomes due, no later than June 30, 2026.

On consent, it is ordered that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenant is terminated unless the Tenant voids this order.

2. **The Tenant may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**

- \$5,103.90 if the payment is made on or before May 31, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.

OR

- \$6,977.64 if the payment is made on or before June 30, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.

3. The Tenant may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenant has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after June 30, 2026 but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenant may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
4. **If the Tenant does not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenant must move out of the rental unit on or before June 30, 2026.**
5. If the Tenant does not void the order, the Tenant shall pay to the Landlord \$2,678.32. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to the date of the hearing and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenant. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
6. The Tenant shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$61.60 per day for the use of the unit starting May 21, 2026 until the date the Tenant moves out of the unit.
7. If the Tenant does not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before June 30, 2026, the Tenant will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from July 1, 2026 at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
8. If the unit is not vacated on or before June 30, 2026, then starting July 1, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.
9. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after July 1, 2026.
