



**Order under Section 69
Residential Tenancies Act, 2006**

SKPM RENTS 11 (the 'Landlord') applied for an order to terminate the tenancy and evict MARCO CHAVES RIVERA and FELICIA HELPS (the 'Tenants') because the Tenants did not pay the rent that the Tenants owe.

This application was scheduled to be heard by videoconference on May 20, 2026. On that date the parties agreed to participate in Board facilitated mediation with the assistance of Dispute Resolution Officer (DRO) Rachael Kukoyi.

The Landlord's Representative, Sharon Harris, and the Tenant, Marco Chaves Rivera (representing both Tenants), participated in the mediation.

As a result of the mediation, the parties requested an order on consent and I am satisfied that the parties understand the terms and consequences of their consent, including waiving their right to a hearing on this application.

The Parties Agreed That:

1. As of the hearing date, the Tenants were still in possession of the rental unit.
2. The lawful rent is \$2,510.22. It is due on the 1st day of each month.
3. Based on the Monthly rent, the daily rent/compensation is \$82.53. This amount is calculated as follows: $\$2,510.22 \times 12$, divided by 365 days.
4. The Tenants have paid \$2,925.88 to the Landlord since the application was filed.
5. The rent arrears owing to May 31, 2026, are \$4,915.00.
6. The Landlord incurred costs of \$186.00 for filing the application and is entitled to reimbursement of those costs.

7. The Landlord collected a rent deposit of \$2,516.40 from the Tenants and this deposit is still being held by the Landlord. The rent deposit can only be applied to the last rental period of the tenancy if the tenancy is terminated.
8. Interest on the rent deposit, in the amount of \$20.27 is owing to the Tenants for the period from January 1, 2026, to May 20, 2026.

It is ordered on consent that:

1. The tenancy between the Landlord and the Tenants is terminated unless the Tenants voids this order.
2. **The Tenants may void this order and continue the tenancy by paying to the Landlord or to the LTB in trust:**

- \$5,101.00 if the payment is made on or before May 31, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.

OR

- \$7,611.22 if the payment is made on or before June 15, 2026. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
3. The Tenants may also make a motion at the LTB to void this order under section 74(11) of the Act, if the Tenants has paid the full amount owing as ordered plus any additional rent that became due after June 15, 2026, but before the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) enforces the eviction. The Tenants may only make this motion once during the tenancy.
 4. **If the Tenants do not pay the amount required to void this order the Tenants must move out of the rental unit on or before June 15, 2026.**
 5. If the Tenants do not void the order, the Tenants shall pay to the Landlord \$1,704.71. This amount includes rent arrears owing up to the date of the hearing and the cost of filing the application. The rent deposit and interest the Landlord owes on the rent deposit are deducted from the amount owing by the Tenants. See Schedule 1 for the calculation of the amount owing.
 6. The Tenants shall also pay the Landlord compensation of \$82.53 per day for the use of the unit starting May 21, 2026, until the date the Tenants moves out of the unit.
 7. If the Tenants do not pay the Landlord the full amount owing on or before June 15, 2026, the Tenants will start to owe interest. This will be simple interest calculated from June 16, 2026, at 4.00% annually on the balance outstanding.
 8. If the unit is not vacated on or before June 15, 2026, then starting June 16, 2026, the Landlord may file this order with the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) so that the eviction may be enforced.

9. Upon receipt of this order, the Court Enforcement Office (Sheriff) is directed to give vacant possession of the unit to the Landlord on or after June 16, 2026.
